Circles are placed in the following cells (row, column): (1,4), (2,3), (2,5), (3,1), (3,4), (3,6), (4,2), (4,4), (4,6), (5,3), (5,5), (6,2), (6,4), (6,5), (6,6). Lines connect some numbers to circles: 7 to (1,4), 3 to (2,3), 6 to (3,1), 5 to (2,5), 1 to (2,4), 8 to (2,6), 5 to (3,4), 2 to (3,5), 9 to (4,2), 6 to (4,4), 5 to (4,6), 8 to (5,3), 1 to (5,4), 6 to (5,5), 5 to (5,6), 7 to (6,2), 6 to (6,4), 5 to (6,5), 2 to (6,6).
