



The grid is a 6x6 square divided into four 3x3 quadrants by a central cross. The numbers and circles are distributed as follows:

- Top-Left Quadrant (Rows 1-3, Columns 1-3):**
 - Row 1: Circle, 1, 6, 2
 - Row 2: 3, Circle
 - Row 3: Circle

Arrows indicate connections between numbers and circles. For example, in the top-left quadrant, an arrow points from the 1 in row 1, column 2 to the circle in row 2, column 3. In the bottom-right quadrant, an arrow points from the 9 in row 5, column 4 to the circle in row 6, column 5.
