- Path 6: (1, 3) → (2, 3) → (3, 3) → (4, 3) → (5, 3) → (6, 3) → (7, 3) → (8, 3) → (9, 3)
- Path 7: (1, 6) → (2, 6) → (3, 6) → (4, 6) → (5, 6) → (6, 6) → (7, 6) → (8, 6) → (9, 6)
- Path 8: (1, 7) → (2, 7) → (3, 7) → (4, 7) → (5, 7) → (6, 7) → (7, 7) → (8, 7) → (9, 7)
- Path 9: (1, 9) → (2, 9) → (3, 9) → (4, 9) → (5, 9) → (6, 9) → (7, 9) → (8, 9) → (9, 9)
