The paths are represented by grey lines connecting circles. The paths are:

- Path 1: Starts at a circle in row 1, column 3, goes right to row 1, column 4, then down to row 2, column 4, then left to row 2, column 3, then up to row 1, column 2, then left to row 1, column 1.
- Path 2: Starts at a circle in row 2, column 5, goes left to row 2, column 4, then left to row 2, column 3, then left to row 2, column 2, then left to row 2, column 1.
- Path 3: Starts at a circle in row 3, column 2, goes right to row 3, column 3, then right to row 3, column 4, then right to row 3, column 5, then right to row 3, column 6.
- Path 4: Starts at a circle in row 4, column 4, goes down to row 5, column 4, then down to row 6, column 4, then down to row 7, column 4, then down to row 8, column 4, then down to row 9, column 4, then down to row 10, column 4.
- Path 5: Starts at a circle in row 5, column 4, goes down to row 6, column 4, then down to row 7, column 4, then down to row 8, column 4, then down to row 9, column 4, then down to row 10, column 4.
- Path 6: Starts at a circle in row 6, column 4, goes down to row 7, column 4, then down to row 8, column 4, then down to row 9, column 4, then down to row 10, column 4.
- Path 7: Starts at a circle in row 7, column 4, goes down to row 8, column 4, then down to row 9, column 4, then down to row 10, column 4.
- Path 8: Starts at a circle in row 8, column 4, goes down to row 9, column 4, then down to row 10, column 4.
- Path 9: Starts at a circle in row 9, column 4, goes down to row 10, column 4.
- Path 10: Starts at a circle in row 10, column 4, goes down to row 11, column 4.
