The paths are represented by thick grey lines connecting circles. The paths are:

- Path 1: Starts at a circle in row 1, column 2; moves right to row 1, column 3; down to row 2, column 3; left to row 2, column 2; down to row 3, column 2; left to row 3, column 1; down to row 4, column 1.
- Path 2: Starts at a circle in row 2, column 4; moves down to row 3, column 4; left to row 3, column 3; down to row 4, column 3; left to row 4, column 2; down to row 5, column 2; left to row 5, column 1.
- Path 3: Starts at a circle in row 3, column 5; moves left to row 3, column 4; down to row 4, column 4; left to row 4, column 3; down to row 5, column 3; left to row 5, column 2; down to row 6, column 2.
- Path 4: Starts at a circle in row 4, column 5; moves left to row 4, column 4; down to row 5, column 4; left to row 5, column 3; down to row 6, column 3.
- Path 5: Starts at a circle in row 5, column 4; moves left to row 5, column 3; down to row 6, column 3.
