The puzzle grid is a 6x6 square. The numbers 4, 5, 6, 6, and 1 are placed in the first, third, fourth, fifth, and sixth rows respectively, in the first, fourth, fifth, sixth, and fourth columns. The comparison symbols are: Row 1, Column 1 to 2 is '>'; Row 2, Column 4 to 5 is '<'; Row 3, Column 3 to 4 is '>'; Row 4, Column 3 to 4 is '>'; Row 5, Column 4 to 5 is '<'; Row 6, Column 2 to 3 is '>'. There are also vertical comparison symbols: Row 2, Column 6 has a downward arrow; Row 3, Column 2 has a downward arrow; Row 4, Column 5 has a downward arrow; Row 5, Column 1 has an upward arrow; Row 6, Column 3 has an upward arrow.
