The puzzle grid is a 6x6 square. The numbers 1, 3, 4, 3, 6 are placed in the following cells: (3,1), (2,3), (2,7), (5,7), (6,4), (6,5).  
 The comparison symbols are placed as follows:  
 Row 1: > between (1,5) and (1,6).  
 Row 2: > between (2,3) and (2,4); > between (2,6) and (2,7).  
 Row 3: > between (3,1) and (3,2); > between (3,3) and (3,4); > between (3,5) and (3,6).  
 Row 4: > between (4,2) and (4,3); > between (4,4) and (4,5); > between (4,6) and (4,7).  
 Row 5: > between (5,4) and (5,5); > between (5,6) and (5,7).  
 Row 6: > between (6,3) and (6,4); > between (6,5) and (6,6).  
 The comparison symbols between rows are:  
 Between row 1 and 2: > between (1,3) and (2,3); > between (1,5) and (2,5).  
 Between row 2 and 3: > between (2,1) and (3,1); > between (2,7) and (3,7).  
 Between row 3 and 4: > between (3,2) and (4,2); > between (3,4) and (4,4); > between (3,6) and (4,6).  
 Between row 4 and 5: > between (4,1) and (5,1); > between (4,3) and (5,3); > between (4,5) and (5,5).  
 Between row 5 and 6: > between (5,2) and (6,2); > between (5,4) and (6,4); > between (5,6) and (6,6).
