The puzzle grid is a 7x7 square. The numbers 1, 3, 7, 6, 3, 5, and 7 are placed in the following cells: (2,1), (2,5), (4,3), (6,2), (7,4), (7,5), and (7,6) respectively. The comparison symbols are placed as follows:

- Row 1: Between (1,3) and (1,4) is '<'.
- Row 2: Between (2,6) and (2,7) is '<'.
- Row 3: Between (3,2) and (3,3) is '>', between (3,4) and (3,5) is '<', and between (3,6) and (3,7) is '>'.
- Row 4: Between (4,5) and (4,6) is '^'.
- Row 5: Between (5,1) and (5,2) is '^', and between (5,7) and (5,8) is 'v'.
- Row 6: Between (6,1) and (6,2) is '<', and between (6,5) and (6,6) is '<'.
- Row 7: Between (7,2) and (7,3) is '>', and between (7,6) and (7,7) is '>'.
