Daily Medium Futoshiki Puzzle for Monday 15th May 2023

The puzzle grid is a 7x7 square. The numbers 3, 5, 4, 1, 2, and 7 are placed in the following cells: (1,5), (2,4), (5,2), (6,7), (7,2), and (7,3) respectively. The comparison symbols are placed as follows:

- Row 2: < between (2,2) and (2,3); < between (2,5) and (2,6)
- Row 3: < between (3,3) and (3,4)
- Row 4: < between (4,3) and (4,4); < between (4,6) and (4,7)
- Row 5: > between (5,1) and (5,2); < between (5,5) and (5,6)
- Row 6: < between (6,2) and (6,3); < between (6,5) and (6,6)
- Row 7: > between (7,6) and (7,7)

Additionally, there are directional arrows indicating constraints between adjacent cells:

- Downward arrows (v) are located between (1,4) and (2,4), (2,1) and (3,1), (3,2) and (4,2), (4,3) and (5,3), (5,4) and (6,4), and (6,5) and (7,5).
- Upward arrows (^) are located between (3,3) and (4,3), and (4,5) and (5,5).
