The paths are: 7(1,1) to 7(2,2) via (1,2), (2,1); 1(1,4) to 1(1,5) via (1,6); 7(2,2) to 2(2,3) via (2,4); 2(2,3) to 4(2,4) via (2,5); 4(2,4) to 4(3,2) via (3,1), (3,3); 8(3,3) to 2(3,4) via (3,5); 9(3,5) to 1(4,4) via (4,5), (4,6); 4(4,1) to 6(4,2) via (4,3); 5(4,3) to 1(4,4) via (4,5); 3(5,1) to 4(5,2) via (5,3); 8(5,3) to 7(5,4) via (5,5); 7(5,4) to 5(5,5) via (5,6); 5(5,5) to 2(5,6) via (5,7); 2(5,6) to 3(5,7) via (5,8); 6(6,2) to 3(6,3) via (6,4); 4(6,4) to 7(6,5) via (6,6).
