Row 7: (1,7)=8, (2,7)=9, (3,7)=4, (4,7)=3, (5,7)=1, (6,7)=9, (7,7)=2, (8,7)=9, (9,7)=7. Row 8: (1,8)=3, (2,8)=5, (3,8)=9, (4,8)=2, (5,8)=1, (6,8)=9, (7,8)=2, (8,8)=9, (9,8)=7. Row 9: (1,9)=4, (2,9)=8, (3,9)=6, (4,9)=5, (5,9)=2, (6,9)=4, (7,9)=5, (8,9)=2, (9,9)=7. Row 10: (1,10)=9, (2,10)=4, (3,10)=6, (4,10)=5, (5,10)=2, (6,10)=4, (7,10)=5, (8,10)=2, (9,10)=7.
