- Row 7:** Column 5 has the number 1; Column 6 has the number 3; Column 7 has a dot; Column 8 has the number 2; Column 9 has the number 4.
- Row 8:** Column 2 has a dot; Column 4 has a dot; Column 6 has the number 7; Column 7 has a dot; Column 8 has a dot.
- Row 9:** Column 2 has a dot; Column 4 has a dot; Column 6 has a dot; Column 7 has a dot; Column 8 has a dot.
- Row 10:** Column 10 has the number 7.
