- Row 6:** Column 1 has '9' and an open circle; Column 2 has a dot; Column 3 has '6' and an open circle; Column 4 has '8' and an open circle; Column 5 has an open circle; Column 6 has '2' and an open circle; Column 7 has a dot; Column 8 has a dot; Column 10 has '4'.
