- Path 1: (1,1) -> (1,2) -> (1,3) -> (1,4) -> (1,5) -> (1,6) -> (1,7) -> (1,8) -> (1,9)
- Path 2: (2,1) -> (2,2) -> (2,3) -> (2,4) -> (2,5) -> (2,6) -> (2,7) -> (2,8) -> (2,9)
- Path 3: (3,1) -> (3,2) -> (3,3) -> (3,4) -> (3,5) -> (3,6) -> (3,7) -> (3,8) -> (3,9)
- Path 4: (4,1) -> (4,2) -> (4,3) -> (4,4) -> (4,5) -> (4,6) -> (4,7) -> (4,8) -> (4,9)
- Path 5: (5,1) -> (5,2) -> (5,3) -> (5,4) -> (5,5) -> (5,6) -> (5,7) -> (5,8) -> (5,9)
- Path 6: (6,1) -> (6,2) -> (6,3) -> (6,4) -> (6,5) -> (6,6) -> (6,7) -> (6,8) -> (6,9)
- Path 7: (7,1) -> (7,2) -> (7,3) -> (7,4) -> (7,5) -> (7,6) -> (7,7) -> (7,8) -> (7,9)
- Path 8: (8,1) -> (8,2) -> (8,3) -> (8,4) -> (8,5) -> (8,6) -> (8,7) -> (8,8) -> (8,9)
- Path 9: (9,1) -> (9,2) -> (9,3) -> (9,4) -> (9,5) -> (9,6) -> (9,7) -> (9,8) -> (9,9)
