The paths are represented by grey lines connecting diamond-shaped nodes. The paths are as follows:

- Path 1: Starts at (1,2), goes right to (2,2), down to (2,3), left to (1,3), up to (1,4), right to (2,4).
- Path 2: Starts at (2,1), goes right to (3,1), down to (3,2), left to (2,2), up to (2,3).
- Path 3: Starts at (3,1), goes right to (4,1), down to (4,2), left to (3,2), up to (3,3).
- Path 4: Starts at (4,1), goes right to (5,1), down to (5,2), left to (4,2), up to (4,3).
- Path 5: Starts at (5,1), goes right to (6,1), down to (6,2), left to (5,2), up to (5,3).
- Path 6: Starts at (6,1), goes right to (7,1), down to (7,2), left to (6,2), up to (6,3).
- Path 7: Starts at (7,1), goes right to (8,1), down to (8,2), left to (7,2), up to (7,3).
- Path 8: Starts at (8,1), goes right to (9,1), down to (9,2), left to (8,2), up to (8,3).
- Path 9: Starts at (9,1), goes right to (10,1), down to (10,2), left to (9,2), up to (9,3).
- Path 10: Starts at (10,1), goes right to (11,1), down to (11,2), left to (10,2), up to (10,3).
