



The puzzle is a 6x6 grid divided into four 3x3 quadrants by a central cross. The grid contains numbers and grey circles. The numbers are placed in the following cells (row, column):

- Top-left quadrant: (1,1)=6, (1,2)=3, (1,3)=7, (2,1)=4, (2,2)=9, (3,1)=5, (3,2)=6, (3,3)=9.
- Top-right quadrant: (1,4)=6, (1,5)=6, (1,6)=9, (2,4)=4, (2,5)=2, (3,4)=6, (3,5)=5, (3,6)=5.
- Bottom-left quadrant: (4,1)=8, (4,2)=5, (4,3)=2, (5,1)=9, (5,2)=5, (5,3)=2, (6,1)=5, (6,2)=2.
- Bottom-right quadrant: (4,4)=1, (4,5)=6, (4,6)=5, (5,4)=6, (5,5)=2, (5,6)=4, (6,4)=2, (6,5)=6.

Grey circles are placed in the following cells (row, column):

- Top-left quadrant: (1,1), (2,1), (3,1), (3,2), (3,3).
- Top-right quadrant: (1,4), (2,4), (2,5), (3,4), (3,5), (3,6).
- Bottom-left quadrant: (4,1), (4,2), (4,3), (5,1), (5,2), (5,3), (6,1), (6,2), (6,3).
- Bottom-right quadrant: (4,4), (4,5), (4,6), (5,4), (5,5), (5,6), (6,4), (6,5), (6,6).

The puzzle is to be solved by connecting the circles with lines that do not cross and do not share a cell with a number.
