- Puzzle 5 (Bottom Middle):** Mines at (2,1), (2,2), (3,1), (3,2). Numbers: (1,2)=8, (2,3)=5, (3,3)=5.
- Puzzle 6 (Bottom Right):** Mines at (2,3), (3,1), (3,2), (3,4). Numbers: (1,2)=6, (2,1)=9, (2,2)=4.
