Grey circles are placed in the following cells (Row, Column): (1,6), (2,3), (2,4), (3,2), (3,5), (4,2), (4,3), (5,1), (5,4), (5,5), (6,1), (6,4), (6,5). Lines connect the circles at (2,3) to (2,4), (3,2) to (3,5), (4,2) to (4,3), (5,4) to (5,5), and (6,1) to (6,4).
