- Bottom-Right Quadrant (Rows 4-6, Columns 4-6):**
 - Row 4: 4 (C4), 7 (C5), 4 (C6)
 - Row 5: 4 (C4, grey circle), 2 (C5, grey circle), 3 (C6)
 - Row 6: 7 (C4, grey circle), 7 (C5), 8 (C6)

Grey lines connect some numbers to circles: (1,2) to (1,3), (2,1) to (2,2), (3,2) to (3,3), (4,2) to (4,3), (5,2) to (5,3), (6,2) to (6,3), (1,4) to (1,5), (2,4) to (2,5), (3,4) to (3,5), (4,4) to (4,5), (5,4) to (5,5), (6,4) to (6,5).
